



MES PTA Summer Reading Incentive Program



Dear Mutual Families,

Research shows that students' comprehension and fluency skills often regress several levels during the summer if they do not read. Our MES teachers and administration, along with the MES PTA want to help our Mutual Mustangs be ready to meet the challenge of a new school year in August! We encourage our students to take part in the new MES PTA Summer Reading Incentive Program and see how successfully they soar through the summer with their reading skills intact!

The MES PTA Summer Reading Log only requires students to read and review a minimum of four grade level books. Books may be read to the younger students, and help in completing the book log may also be given. Students entering grades 3-5 should complete the book log independently. Parents are asked to sign the Summer Reading Log prior to returning it to school at the beginning of the school year.

Students who participate in this program will be recognized during Open House, receive a certificate to honor their achievement, and receive a variety of small rewards from the PTA.

This program is not mandatory, but we are hoping for strong participation from our Mutual Mustangs! Students have nine weeks during summer break to complete the attached reading log. Reading logs will need to be turned in to your child's teacher by Wednesday, August 25th.
